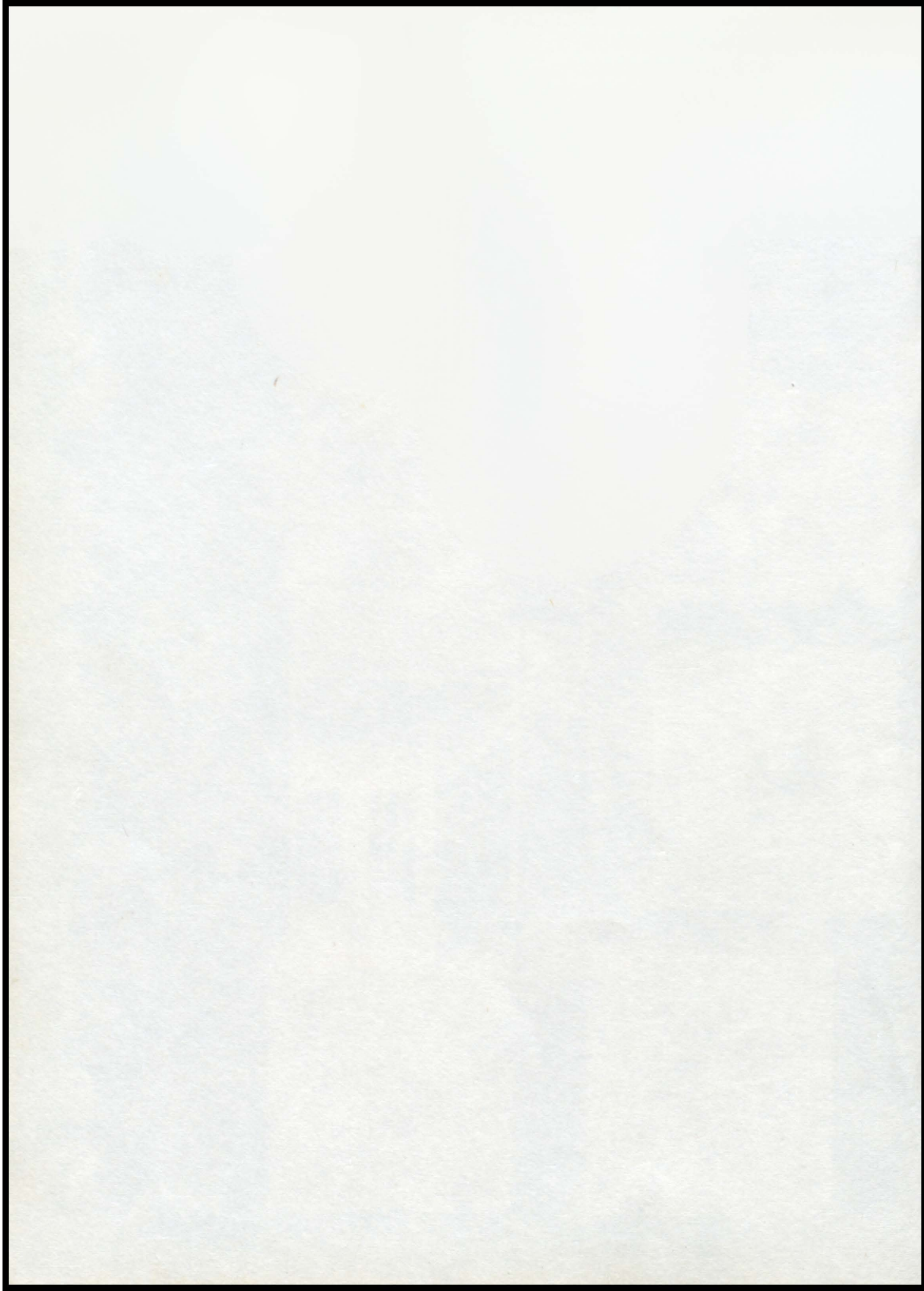


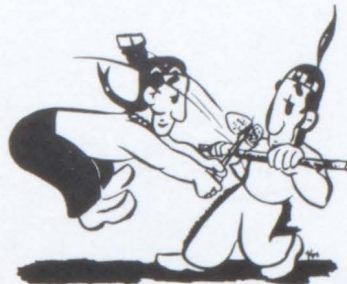

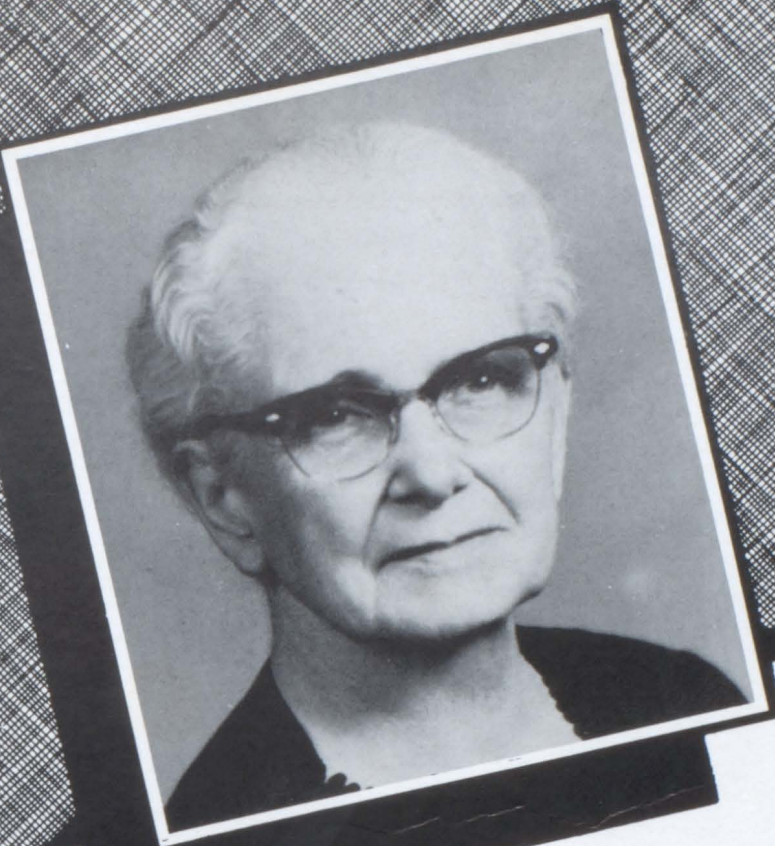

By this dedication we wish to express our feeling of gratitude for having had as a teacher such a fine person who has devoted so much of her life to the field of education.



Steve Skersick--A big designer for ladies' bathing suits in Chicago. On the sidelines he has his eye on a little blonde. (Wonder who that is?)


Janet Rae Urbin--She was known for her beautiful voice and is now singing with the Kixie Drops, five chickens and Dean.

I, Steve Skersick, being of sound mind and body do hereby will and bequeath my big flat feet to Ann Anderson.

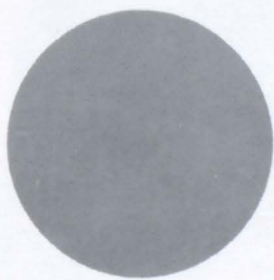
