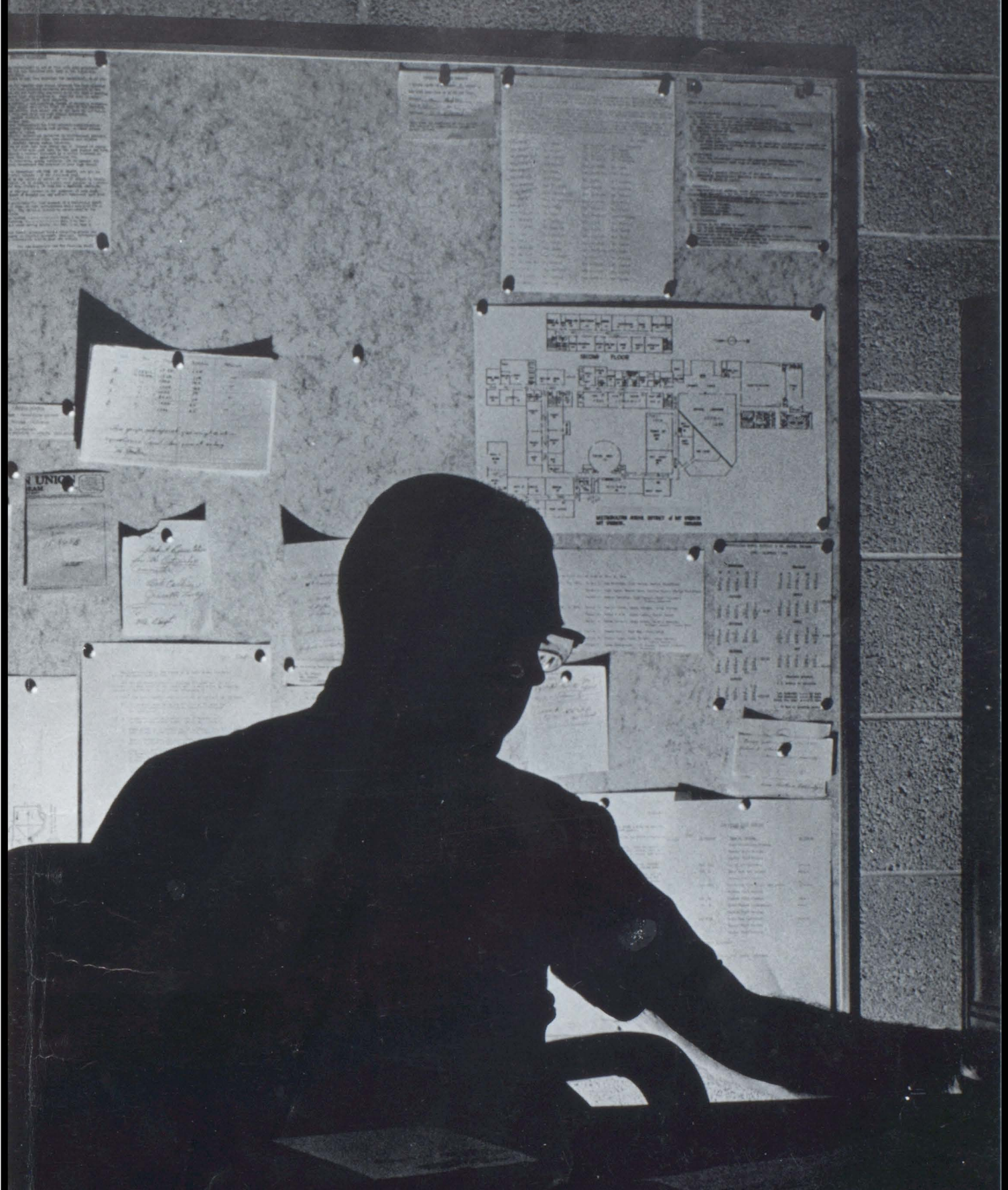
We, the graduating class of 1967, dedicate the 1967 Kewannian to our parents, our teachers and our school.

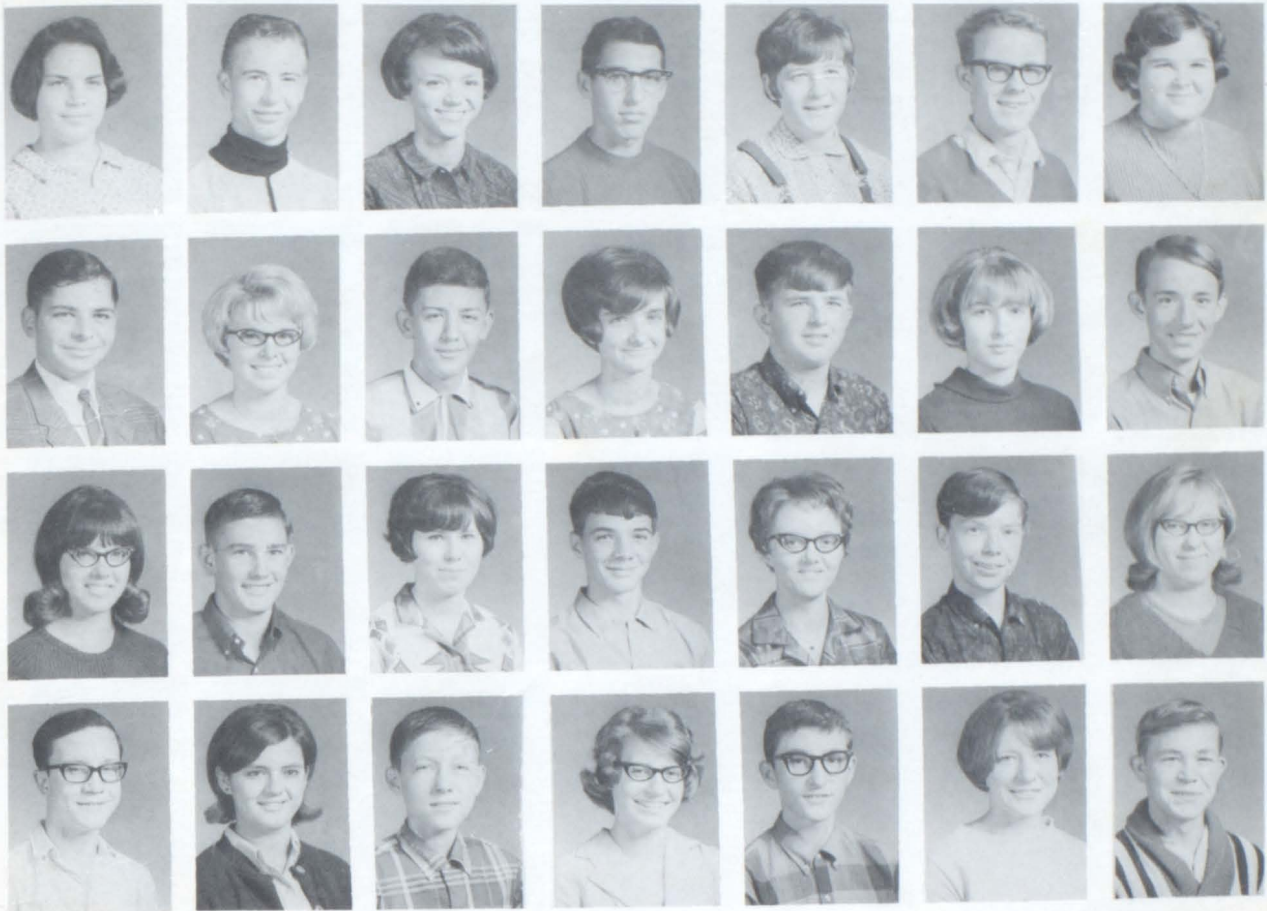
