Joan Lamb has made it big after becoming secretary of the H.S.&M. firm in Rochester.

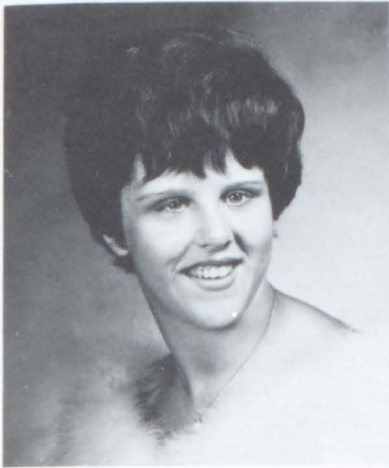
Tom Overmyer has become very prosperous by opening his "Eluder Car Factory".

Donna Miller just returned to the United States after her husband Dave, finally returned from the Air Force.

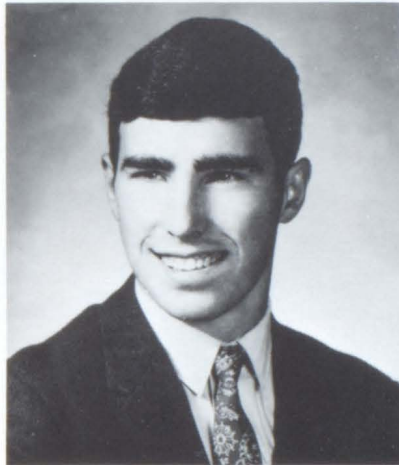
