Well-----nothing else exciting happened today. But I can say one thing, Jon did a good job on my hair. In fact—I think that I looked pretty cute today.

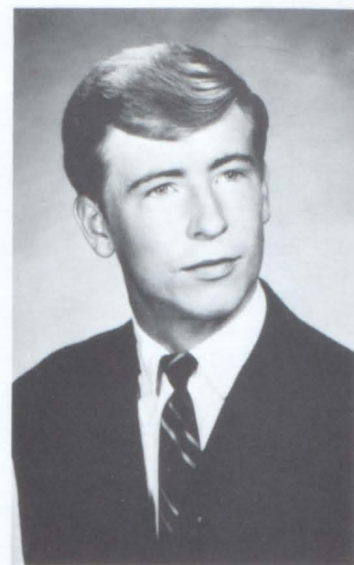
