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farm named "Hoosier Homestead Farm"

Mrs. Jeanette Hunter and several members of her family were in Indianapolis Wednesday, August 12, to receive a Hoosier Homestead Farm award in ceremonies held during the Indiana State Fair. The award was presented to the Collins family farm located on County Road 100 S, northeast of Kewanna. The Hoosier Homestead award program honors families that have held ownership of their family farm for 100 years or more.

Lt. Governor Becky Skillman presented the awards, assisted by Representative Doug Gutwein and Director of Agriculture Diane Hazlett.

During the ceremony, plaques were presented and pictures take of 36 families that received the 100-year award. Ten families received the 150-year award. Twenty-six Indiana counties were represented in this year's award group. Approximately 300 people were in attendance to hear speeches given noting the perseverance and dedication necessary to hold ownership through world wars, depression and years of low farm income.

The Hoosier Homestead award program was started in 1976 and is part of the Indiana Department of Agriculture. Since the beginning of the program, 4,500 families throughout the state have been honored.



Crop insurance protection is one of the requirements under the permanent disaster assistance programs of the 2008 farm bill.

A number of banks that were straddling the middle of the road last quarter, have now slipped from adequate to problematic. The number of banks rated 2-stars or below has now reached 899.





Kara Smith again led the varsity girls with a time of 24:55 followed by Veronica Sheets,

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
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Fire department gets new radios
