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The Lake Bruce Conservancy District met Thursday, April 8, in the community room of the Kewanna-Union Township Fire Station. Directors present included Gerald Porter, Brad Glasson, Rick Tompos and Paul Bradley, plus seven freeholders and one guest.

The minutes of the February meeting were approved as were the treasurer's report by Rick Tompos and the sewer billing report by Brad Glasson. Porter covered the correspondence for the month. Along with the regular bills, the district received its tax rate notice for 2010 from the Department of Local Government Finance. Porter also gave a legal update on some of the properties that have not complied with the sewer ordinances. The district continues to notify owners of violations and file liens for nonpayment of bills. The board agreed to amend the lien form to include a notice to any legal firm searching lien records that the district's sewer liens are subordinate only to county taxes.

The wastewater treatment plant operator, Richard Denny, reported that the plant is running very well. There were no violations for the month of AERO-MOD March. has recommended a solution to a control air problem at the treatment plant. Their solution has been approved and involves an equipment swap that should be completed in early May. Inspector Paul Bradley reported no connection activity for the period.

Chairman Porter gave the lake enhancement report. Notification was received from the LARE program that Lake Bruce will not receive any assistance with weed control in 2010. The district did receive its weed treatment permit and it was forwarded to Tony Cunningham of Weed Patrol. He is scheduled to do a survey in April to map the lake and formulate a plan for treatment.

The last order of business was to remind all in attendance that the geese are beginning to nest and it is time to get a permit to treat the eggs to keep them from hatching. For more information, call Gerald Porter at 574-653-9984.

The meeting adjourned at 7:40 p.m. The board of directors will not meet in May. The next meeting will be Thursday, June 10, at 7 p.m. in the community room of the Kewanna fire station.

Local Officials urge homeowners to complete form:

Pink form helps taxpayers save green

When taxpayers in Fulton County receive their property tax bills in the mail in the coming days, they will want to pay close attention to the pink piece of paper that accompanies the bill.

The pink or rose-colored form

The pink or rose-colored form is the "homestead verification form," and it must be completed if homeowners want to continue receiving the benefit of the homestead deduction – the most commonly used property tax deduction in Indiana.

"Completing the form confirms that the individual is using the property as his or her permanent home, an eligibility requirement of the deduction," County Auditor Judy Reed said.

Individuals or married couples claiming the homestead deduction must provide the last five digits of their driver's license and social security numbers. This information will be placed in a secure database that will enable all county auditors in Indiana to crosscheck names, identifying those who may be claiming a homestead deduction in more than one county.

"The homestead deduction gives a qualifying individual or couple a substantial property tax benefit by lowering their property tax obligation," County Auditor Judy Reed said. "When individuals who do not qualify receive this benefit, it costs other taxpayers more."

The homestead deduction allows homeowners who use a property as a primary residence to qualify for a reduction of up to 60 percent of the initial gross assessed value, plus up to an additional 35 percent of the remaining assessed value. Finally, it is through the homestead deduction that county assessors and auditors identify which taxpayers receive the benefit of the one percent property tax cap.

Pulaski County Public Library

Communities Thrive @ Your Library

This week, schools, campuses and communities across the country celebrate National Library Week, a time to remind the public about the contribution libraries, librarians and library workers make to their communities every day.

In today's tough economy, libraries offer free resources to people of all ages where they can find entertainment, develop skills and come to find their place in the community. People gather for book discussions, for story time with their children or to take computer classes. The Pulaski County Public Library truly helps the community thrive.

To get a better understanding of what to expect in 2010, it's beneficial to look back at the 2009 library statistics. The Pulaski County Public Library serves nine townships in Pulaski County, with a total population of 10,646. Of the district population, 68% of the residents have a library card. There were 137,805 items circulated at the two branches during 2009, an increase of nearly 13% over the previous year.

Demand for Internet access increase continues to exponentially, with a total of 13,253 patrons utilizing the computers for over library 14,230 hours last year. In an effort to meet the growing demand, the number computer workstations has increased nearly to computers for public use. Additionally, both the Winamac Medaryville and branches provide free wireless Internet access 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, which is accessible from inside and outside of the libraries.

Did you know the Library is now automatically receiving books on their publishing date? This means that popular titles from over 300 selected authors will be available at the Library near their release date. When comparing the Library holdings Weekly's Publishers bestseller list, each of the top five books listed is currently available @ your library. An excellent way to tell if the Library has the book you are looking for is to check on the online card catalog.

accessed http://catalog.pulaskicounty.lib.i n.us/webopac Once you have arrived at the online card catalog, type the author's name or book title into the text box. When you located the item among the search results, you then determine availability. If an item is checked out, you can place a reserve on the item from the online card catalog. Simply click on "Reserve Item" and enter your library card barcode. This will reserve the item under your name, and when the item is returned, you will be notified by the library staff.

The recent renovation at the Winamac branch has enabled the library to begin to offer regular programming. During 2008, the Library was only able to provide programming for 21 children's programs and 75 adult programs, for a total of 96 programs. Following the

expansion, the Library was able to offer 211 children's programs and 150 adult programs, for a total of 361 programs in 2009. With the increased amount of programming, the attendance for library programs has risen from 913 in 2008 to 3, 574 in 2009. That's a 276% increase in programming opportunities and a 291% increase in program attendance from 2008.

The Library is offering many exciting events each week. Upcoming activities are featured on Rensselaer TV Cable Channel 15, in the Kewanna Observer, Francesville Tribune, Pulaski County Journal, and as well as in a monthly newsletter available at the libraries. This summer will feature the introduction of a summer reading program for adults as well as children. Sponsorship opportunities are still available for the summer reading programs, and inquiries can be directed to Linda Ruhl or Virginia Kennedy. information on summer reading activities will be available in early May.

This is just a snapshot of the various annual statistics and activities of the Pulaski County Public Library, and provides only a brief bit of insight into the magnitude of services and programs available. One item cannot be measured statistically is the integral role the library staff plays in advancing the services and programs of the library. Behind the scenes is a library staff member working diligently to create and organize wellrounded services and programs.

I hope you will consider attending a library program or exploring the services available to you here @ your library. We make our plans with you in mind, and your attendance and patronage is greatly appreciated. As we work to

strengthen the services and programs provided by the Library, we hope you will feel pleased and proud of your Pulaski County Public Library.

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


